## Required Courses

- The listed courses are Mankato Area Public Schools' 9th grade required courses.
- Some requirements offer more than one option:

- R standard required course
- R advanced required course

**Choose only one option.**

- For 9th Grade Physical Education, only one course option is available.

## Elective Courses

- E or E Elective courses are either .5 credit (one semester) or 1 credit (full year).
- Using the spaces provided, students must enter electives that total between 1.5 credits and 2.5 credits.
  - \* If 1.5 elective credits are chosen, the student will have a study hall for the entire year.
  - \* If 2 elective credits are chosen, the student will have a study hall for only one semester (semester cannot be chosen).
  - \* If 2.5 elective credits are chosen, the student will have a full schedule with no study hall either semester.
- All students must complete 7-11 elective credits between grades 9-12.

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## Required Courses

- For 10th Grade Physical Education and Health requirements, only one course option is available.

## Elective Courses

- E** or **E** Elective courses are either .5 credit (one semester) or 1 credit (full year).
- Using the spaces provided, students must enter electives that total between 1 credit and 2 credits.
  - \* If 1 elective credit is chosen, the student will have a study hall for the entire year.
  - \* If 1.5 elective credits are chosen, the student will have a study hall for only one semester (semester cannot be chosen).
  - \* If 2 elective credits are chosen, the student will have a full schedule with no study hall either semester.
- All students must complete 7-11 elective credits between grades 9-12.

# Planning: Grade 12



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## Required Courses

- The listed courses are Mankato Area Public Schools' 12th grade required courses.
- Some requirements offer more than one option:

- R** standard required course
- R** advanced required course

Choose only one option.

- Although only 3 years of math are required for graduation, most colleges and universities recommend or require 4 years for admission. Courses listed under Mathematics Electives are the recommended courses to fulfill this requirement.

## Elective Courses

- E** or **E** Elective courses are either .5 credit (one semester) or 1 credit (full year).
- Using the spaces provided, students must enter electives that will complete their elective requirements for graduation. All students must complete 7-11 elective credits between grades 9-12.
- The total number of elective course credits combined with the total number of required course credits should equal between 6-7 credits total.
